On this 29th day of October, before me, the undersigned,

a Justice of the Peace in and for the County and State aforesaid, personally appeared Mary Eignor and Maria Eignor who on oath swore that on the 9th day of January, A.D. 1881, they were present at the wedding of Catherine Eignor and Minnie Decker, both residents of Shandaken, in the County and State aforesaid; that they saw the aforesaid parties joined together on that evening in the bonds of holy and lawful wedlock; and that the marriage ceremonies were solemnized by one Thomas Smith, a Justice of the Peace residing at Shandaken aforesaid. That said wedding was at the house of Catherine Eignor's father, John Eignor, in the town of Shandaken aforesaid.

They further swear that they have ever since been acquainted with the aforesaid parties and know that from the date of said marriage to the time of Minnie Decker's going to the war as a Federal soldier, they lived together, and cohabited, and spoke of each other as husband and wife, & were so reported all in their neighborhood.

That the said Catherine Eignor is the identical Catherine Decker who is an applicant for Minnie's pension. In view of the death of her husband Minnie Decker, who was a member of Co. H in the 20th Regt. N.Y. S. Militia and who was killed at Gettysburg on the 28th of July, 1863. That they know that the said soldier and the husband of said Catherine Decker, were one and the same man, Minnie Decker above named; that they have personal knowledge of this soldier, and have heard from him while in said Co. H, of said Regiment - and have had the most reliable information of his death.

That they know that the said Catherine Decker has not married since the death of her husband the deceased soldier above named, and that she is now the widow of her said husband. That they are residents of Shandaken aforesaid, & have no interest in the pension which ~~is~~ ^{is} the subject of this claim for pension which this proof of marriage is intended to support.
