M. 1805 Volunteers, to serve years, or during the war, and mustered into service as a Private on the 23 day of Sept. 1861, at Wingshire N. Y., in Co. No. 213 Regiment of A. G. V. M. 1805 Volunteers, to serve years during the war. On the Mounts Dr. of Co. No. 213 of that Regiment, for the months of July and August 1862, he is reported at Donnamant and "Wingshire" at the battle of Gettysburg Sep. 30 1863.
